

My definition of postmarks

Background

Postmarks in the Proud book has an id that does not say much about the postmark itself except that killer postmarks get a K plus index, a circular date stamp gets a D plus index etcetera. This means that the property of a postmark can't be compared between different post offices. My idea is that a 'C1' postmark is similar to another 'C1' postmark for another village

Numeral cancellations

The numeral cancellations are circular two circle or three circle with a number in centre named N1a-N1c or killer cancellations named K1 and KD1 with some sub types.

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Date stamps

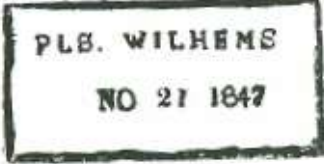
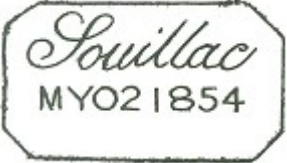
The numeral series (including B53) was withdrawn in 1893, and datestamps then became standard through the country. There are five circular date stamp main types, A to D and PB including a lot of sub types. There are two square type date stamps SQ1 and SQ2 and a machine postmark type named MP.

	A	CDS with single circle diameter 23 mm and post office name in upper circumference and ornament(fleuron) at base. Day and month and (usually) a two digit year above ornament.	
	B1	CDS with single circle diameter 19½ mm and straight post office name in the middle and no country name. Thimble type.	
	B2	CDS with single circle diameter 19-21 mm and post office name in upper circumference, date on two lines with year expressed with 2 figures and no country name. Thimble type. For Port Louis cancellations diameter can be up to 26 mm	
	B3	CDS with single circle diameter 19½mm and post office name in upper circumference, date on two lines and no country name. Year expressed with four figures Thimble type.	This mark was introduced for all offices on January 1 1900
	B3a	Year expressed with two figures	Diameter about 22 mm. Only 'Trou-aux-Biches'
	B3b	Year expressed with one figure

	C1	CDS with single circle diameter 23-25 mm and post office name in upper circumference. MAURITIUS in lower. Date on two lines and year expressed with two figures.	This postmark was used in 61 post offices from 1910.

	DT	CDS with double frame 27 mm in diameter	Main type
	DT1	CDS with double frame, with slugs, time and MAURITIUS at bottom	"Birmingham"
	DT1c	No country name	
	DT2	CDS with double frame, with arcs, time and MAURITIUS at bottom	"New Birmingham"
	DT2c	Same as above but no arcs	

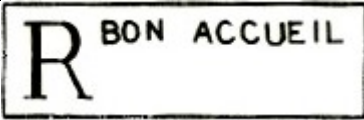
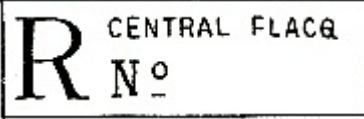
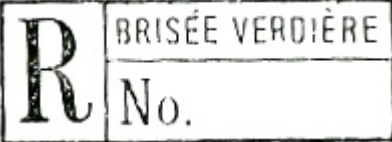
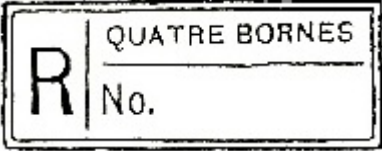

CASCADE HALT	L	Straight line cancellation, no date	Only found in Cascade Road
